### § 1

The **Sponsored** declare, that it is the organizer of the symposium **New Trends in the Metallic Materials Processing, 4<sup>th</sup> edition** which will take place on 16-18.05.2023 in Bucharest, Romania.

### § 2

1. The **Sponsored** obligations are to carry following promotion actions dedicated to the **Sponsor**:

- Company's logo on all pages of the symposium's website.
- Setting Sponsor's logo with link on the symposium website: [newtrends.foundry-conference.com](http://newtrends.foundry-conference.com).
- Setting Sponsor's banner (roll-up banner) in a visible place during the event in the symposium venue. Banner (roll-up banner) must be provided by sponsor.
- Naming the Sponsor during official part of celebration of symposium.
- Handing out of Sponsor's promotional materials together with the symposium map (brochures or other promotional materials must be provided by sponsor).
- Handing out promotional materials in the symposium venue.
- Free participation for 2 persons at the events connected to the symposium (symposium, welcome cocktail, lunch, official dinner).
- Booth in the lobby of the symposium hall consisting of a desk, two chairs and 4 display panels (1 x 2 x 1 m).
- Free advertisement (1 page) in one of the issues of the Romanian Foundry Journal in 2023 (polychrome or B&W, article or advertise).
- Sending a copy of each issue of the RFJ released in 2023.

### § 3

1. For the title of **Sponsor** and all the services mentioned in §2, the **Sponsor** will be charged the amount of 650 Euro (six hundred fifty) or 3.250 RON (three thousand two hundred fifty).

within 7 days from the date of receipt of the invoice, indicating in the payment order "Sponsoring the symposium NTMMP, 4<sup>th</sup> edition".

3. All bank costs have to be paid by the sender (**Sponsor**).

### §4

1. The **Sponsored** reserves the right - in the event of circumstances beyond its control, in particular the introduction of restrictions related to the COVID-19 epidemic or military conflict, to change the symposium formula to on-line or hybrid (stationary + online).

2. If the symposium is organized in an online or hybrid form, for reasons beyond the control of the **Sponsored**, the **Sponsor** is not entitled to a refund of the amount indicated in § 3, and the actions indicated in § 2 will be adjusted to the adopted form of the symposium.

3. In the event of:

a) canceling the symposium - the **Sponsored** will return to the **Sponsor** the amount indicated in §3 less the amounts necessary for promotional activities for the **Sponsor** until the symposium is canceled,

b) postponing of the symposium to a new date for reasons beyond the control of the **Sponsored** results in the transfer of the fee paid by the **Sponsor** to the next date of the symposium.
