

PARTICIPATION REGULATIONS
International Symposium
“New Trends in Metallic Material Processing”,
4th edition
May 16-18, 2023, Bucharest

1. The Organizers of the **International Symposium “New Trends in Metallic Material Processing” (NTMMP 2023)** are the “Politehnica” University of Bucharest, Faculty of Materials Science and Engineering, Department for Metallic Materials Processing and the Romanian Foundry Technical Association (ATTR) with the support of the Polish Foundrymen’s Association.
2. The condition for participation in the symposium is registration via the on-line application form available on the symposium website: <https://newtrends.foundry-conference.com/> by April 30, 2023.
3. Symposium registration includes a few categories of participants: Lecturer (university, R&D Institution) / Lecturer (student) / Lecturer (company) - with an oral presentation and Participant Standard / Student / Accompanying person and Company Promotional Package.
4. The Participant who wants to present a paper at the symposium must register through the registration system and upload the abstract. Information about abstract acceptance will be sent within 14 days. The deadline for abstract submission is March 31st, 2023.
5. After abstract acceptance, the invoice will be prepared and sent to the participant by e-mail.
6. Payments should be done by bank transfer to the ATTR account in maximum 7 days after receiving the invoice but not later than April 30th, 2023, without any claim for a refund in the case of absence of the person registered for the symposium (see paragraph 12.b Conditions for resignation).
7. Applications sent after May 1st, 2023 will not be considered.
8. The condition for participation to the symposium is that the full participation fee is credited to the ATTR account no later by April 30th, 2023.
9. Participants are required to individually book rooms directly in the Hotel and pay the appropriate fee. The conditions for booking rooms are specified by the Hotel. The Organizers are not responsible for the rules formulated by the Hotel.

 - c. Lack of the full payment for participation is equal to resignation from participation in the symposium.
 - d. It is allowed to change the person enlisted by May 10th, 2023, after informing the Organizers.

The Organizers reserve the right - in the event of circumstances beyond their control, in particular the introduction of restrictions related to the epidemic of a dangerous infectious disease (i.e., COVID-19) or military conflict to change the conference formula to a remote or hybrid (stationary + remote).
14. If the symposium is organized in a remote or hybrid form, for reasons beyond the control of the Organizers, the Participant is not entitled to reimbursement of participation fees and the right to receive compensation.
